VIRGINIA WATERS – PLEASANTVILLE

The District of Virginia Waters – Pleasantville shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline of Robin Hood Bay and the City of St. John's Municipal Boundary (1998);

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the said Municipal Boundary to its intersection with the centre line of Logy Bay Road;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the centre line of Logy Bay Road to its intersection with the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway, also known as the Outer Ring Road;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the centre line of the Trans-Canada Highway to its intersection with the centre line of Torbay Road;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the centre line of Torbay Road to its intersection with the centre line of Kenna's Hill;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the centre line of Kenna's Hill to its intersection with the centre line of King's Bridge Road;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the centre line of King's Bridge Road to its intersection with the centre line of Rennie's River;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the centre line of Rennie's River to its intersection with the western shoreline of Quidi Vidi Lake;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the sinuosities of the northern shoreline of Quidi Vidi Lake to its intersection with the northern shoreline of Quidi Vidi River;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the sinuosities of the northern shoreline of Quidi Vidi River to its intersection with the shoreline of Quidi Vidi Harbour;

Thence running in a general southeasterly and northerly direction along the sinuosities of the shoreline to the point of beginning.

Note: This District includes part of the City of St. John's.
