

PIPPY PARK

The District of Pippy Park shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centre line of Torbay Road and the centre line of MacDonald Drive;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of MacDonald Drive to its intersection with the centre line of Prince Philip Drive;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of Prince Philip Drive to its intersection with the centre line of Allandale Road;

Thence running in a general northerly and westerly direction along the centre line of Allandale Road to its intersection with the centre line of the Trans Canada Highway, also known as the Outer Ring Road;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the centre line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the centre line of Thorburn Road;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the centre line of Thorburn Road to its intersection with the City of St. John's Municipal Boundary (1998);

Thence running in a general westerly, northeasterly and southeasterly direction along the said Municipal Boundary to its intersection with the centre line of Logy Bay Road;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the centre line of Logy Bay Road to its intersection with the centre line of the Trans Canada Highway, also known as the Outer Ring Road;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the centre line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the centre line of Torbay Road;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the centre line of Torbay Road to the point of beginning.

Note: This District includes part of the City of St. John's.
